



PATIENT INSTRUCTIONS – GENERAL ANAESTHESIA

If you have been advised by Dr Alayan that you require general anaesthetic for your procedure, please ensure you have:

1. Updated your personal details with BCPI.
2. Received a treatment plan with item codes and an estimate of costs from Dr Alayan.
3. Asked any questions you may have regarding your treatment and associated risks and ensure that you understand what your treatment involves.
4. Read, understood and signed
 - o BCPI Consent form
 - o BCPI GA Information form
 - o St Andrews Consent Form
5. Provided your private health fund and Medicare details to BCPI.
6. Provided an updated medical history to BCPI, the anaesthetist, St Andrews hospital, your general dental practitioner.
7. Paid 10% deposit to Dr Alayan to secure your booking.
8. Contacted your health fund to enquire about your rebate.

ONE WEEK PRIOR TO YOUR PROCEDURE YOU SHOULD HAVE:

1. Received a Confirmation of Appointment pack from BCPI including:
 - o Confirming letter stating time to arrive at St Andrews
 - o Post Operative instructions (read these prior to your procedure to ensure you understand what care is necessary after your procedure)
 - o General anaesthetic patient instructions
 - o St Andrews carpark form
2. Paid the balance of Dr Alayan's treatment estimate.
3. Received correspondence/communication from the anaesthetist's rooms and responded accordingly.
4. Understood the fasting requirements prior to your surgery.
